Already getting things done

Chris made “Housing First” a priority, establishing shelters and transitional housing units rather than tents and parks. He advocated for the Navigation Center and more coordination of services and sponsored legislation to allow state property use for shelters.

Chris took on the affordable housing shortage with rental assistance and removal of barriers to multi-family housing and mixed-use housing close to transit services.

Chris aggressively pursued improved water treatment and a new ozone treatment plant. He supported strengthening the Tree Code for tree protection and increased planting. And he helped create Salem’s Climate Action Plan.
